

Celtic Prayer Card

Supply List

- Dot or standard graph paper (add link for printable)
- Heavy weight watercolor paper
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Permanent ink pen
- Watercolor paints, markers or colored pencil
- Optional: printer, paper, glue

1. On graph paper practice Celtic knot lightly in pencil
2. Choose a verse or prayer
3. Plan size to fit border design and verse/prayer
4. Create border completely on graph paper
5. Transfer to watercolor paper (pencil rub method)
6. If needed trace with pencil
7. Layout lettering lines lightly in pencil fill in verse/prayer (or print in a lovey font on high quality paper - to be glued on later - skip step 8)
8. Ink lettering with chisel tipped pen
9. Trace outlines with ink
10. Color border design
11. Optional: cut and paste printed verse/prayer

Other design options:

- Fill the front of the card with Celtic knot work and write verse/prayer on the back
- Layer with colored card stock
- Laminate
- Make as a booklet
- Add a tassel
